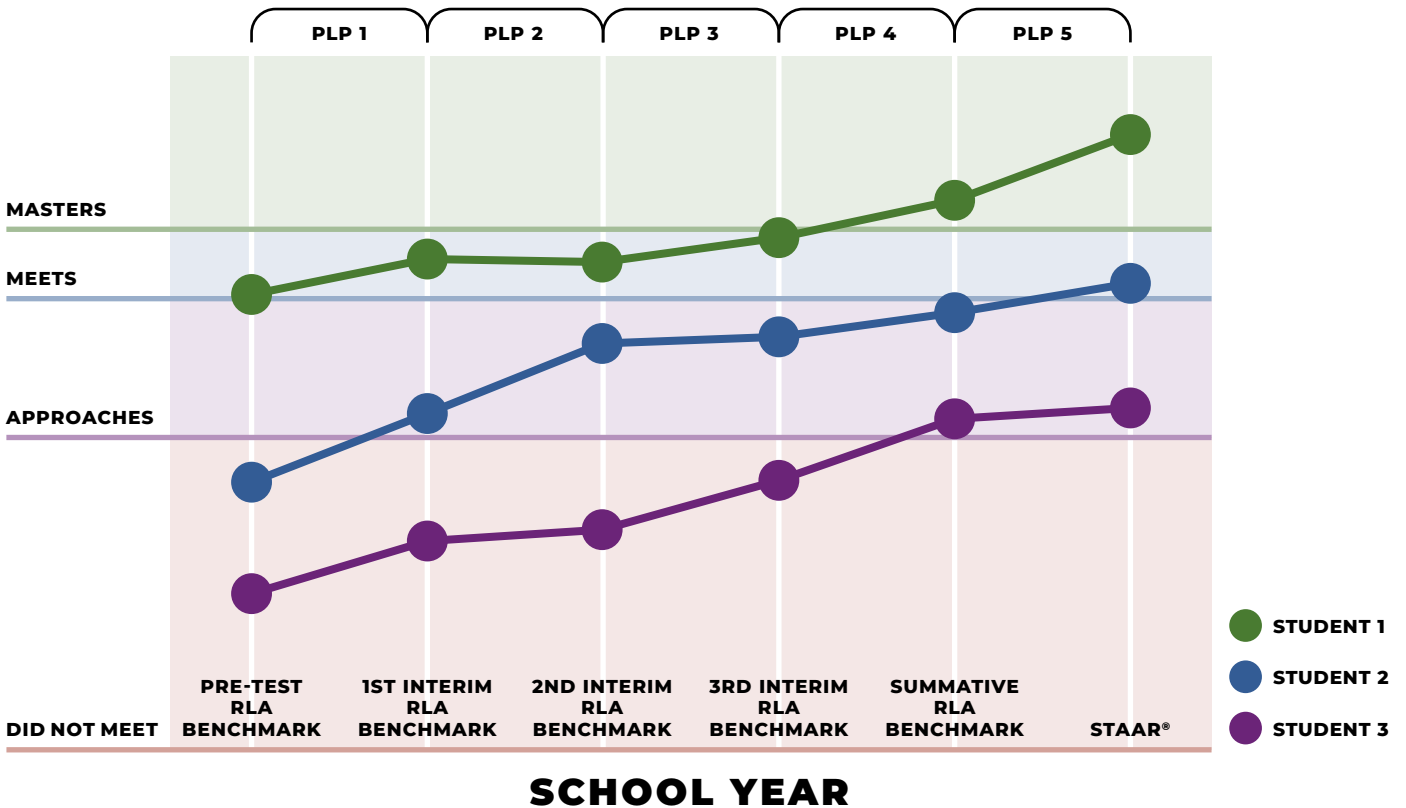

8 Earth's solid, rocky crust is broken into about 20 large sections called plates. The edges of some plates slowly move away from each other. The edges of some plates collide, or move against each other. Near Italy, the edges of two plates are colliding. This powerful motion causes one plate to sink beneath the other. 

vampire bat

Adaptations help animals do many different things. For example, many adaptations help animals get food.

This vampire bat's nose helps it find food. Its nose can find a warm blood vessel on an animal. Then the vampire bat knows where to use its sharp teeth to make a tiny hole. When blood flows out of the hole, the vampire bat uses its tongue to lick up its meal of blood.



It is important for animals to find food. It is also important for animals to avoid becoming food for other animals. For this reason, many adaptations help animals avoid **predators**, or animals that might eat them.


Some animals run away from predators. The American pronghorns in the picture can run very fast for a long time. This often allows them to escape from their predators.

Other animals try to scare predators away. The king cobra snake can make the skin on its neck widen into a hood. It also raises its body and hisses very loudly.

▼ The king cobra can raise itself up to 1/3 of its body length.



▼ These American pronghorns can run at speeds up to 100 kilometers per hour (62 miles per hour).

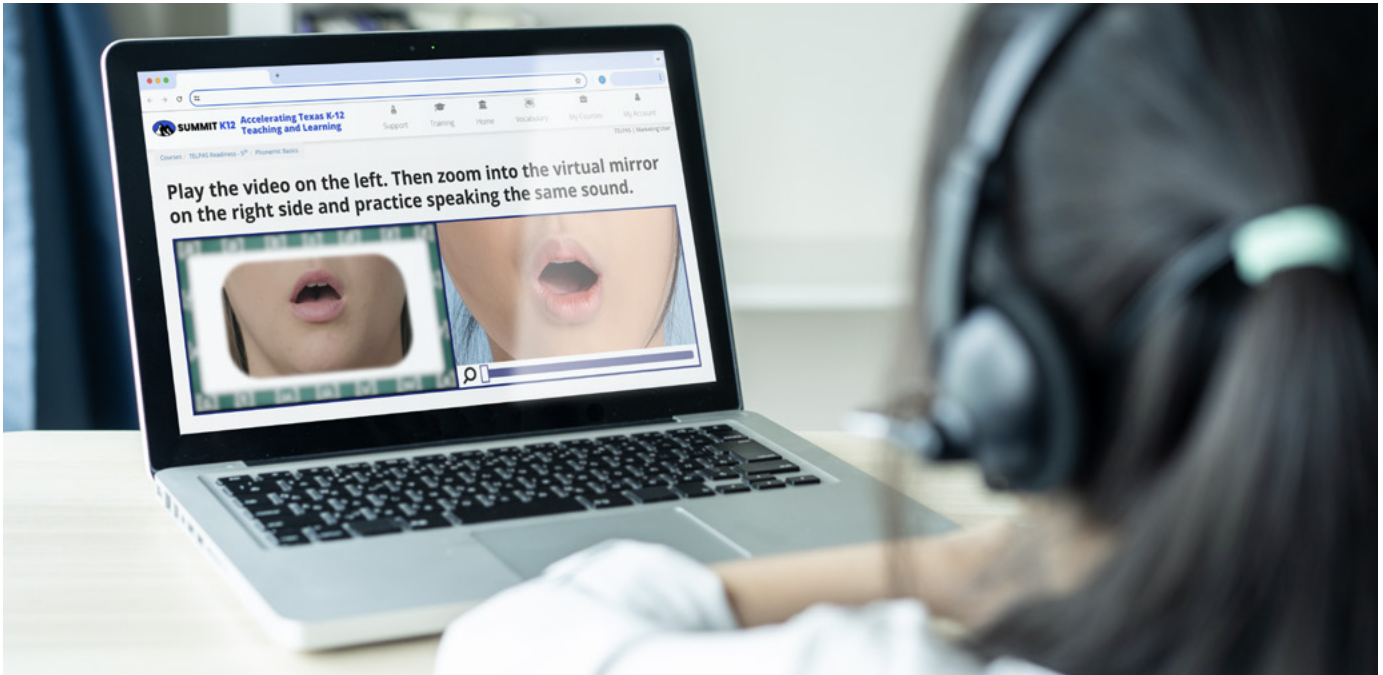


